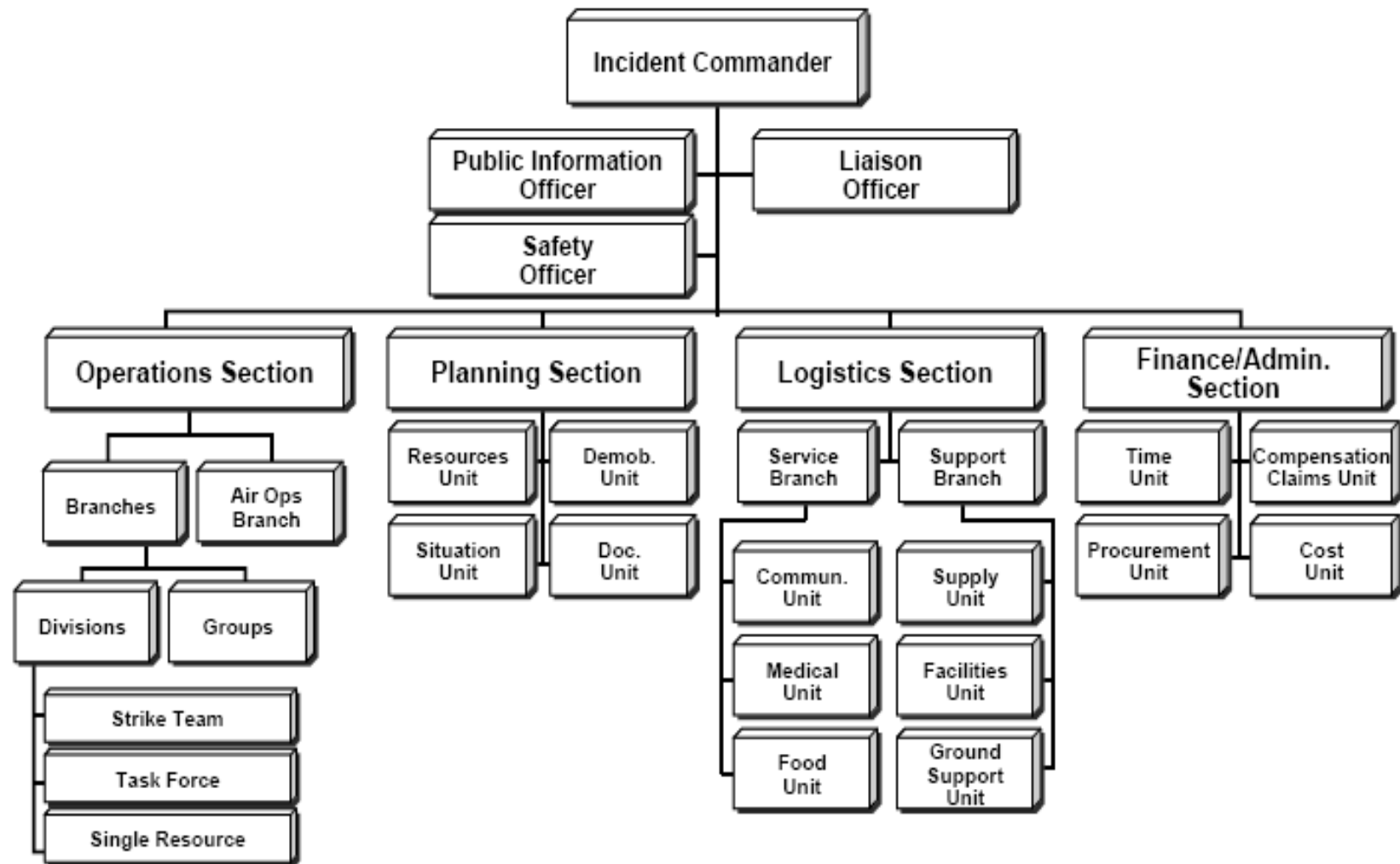

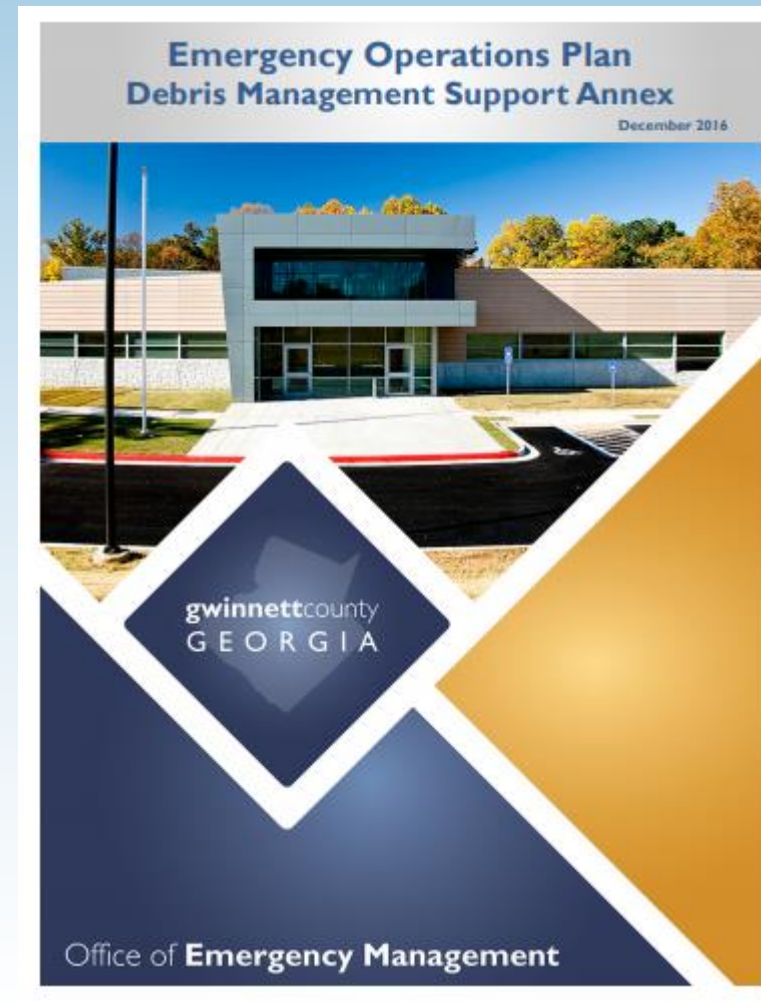

Weather Awareness Statement 49 September 2017 8:38 pm

The projected path of Hurricane Irma continues north, up the west coast of Florida and moving through and Tennessee. This is a large hurricane, with tropical storm force winds over 300 miles across.


The impacts to Gwinnett County are becoming more certain, and based on this wind track and strength destructive winds, tornadoes and flash flooding continue to appear likely.

What This Means

- Tropical Storm Force winds could arrive as early as mid-Monday through Tuesday morning
- Destructive winds, tornadoes and flash flooding are possible
- Sustained winds of 35 to 40 mph with gusts of 45 to 65 mph are likely
- Trees and power lines will be downed, and power outages may last over 24 hours
- Travel disruptions and delays due to road debris may be substantial



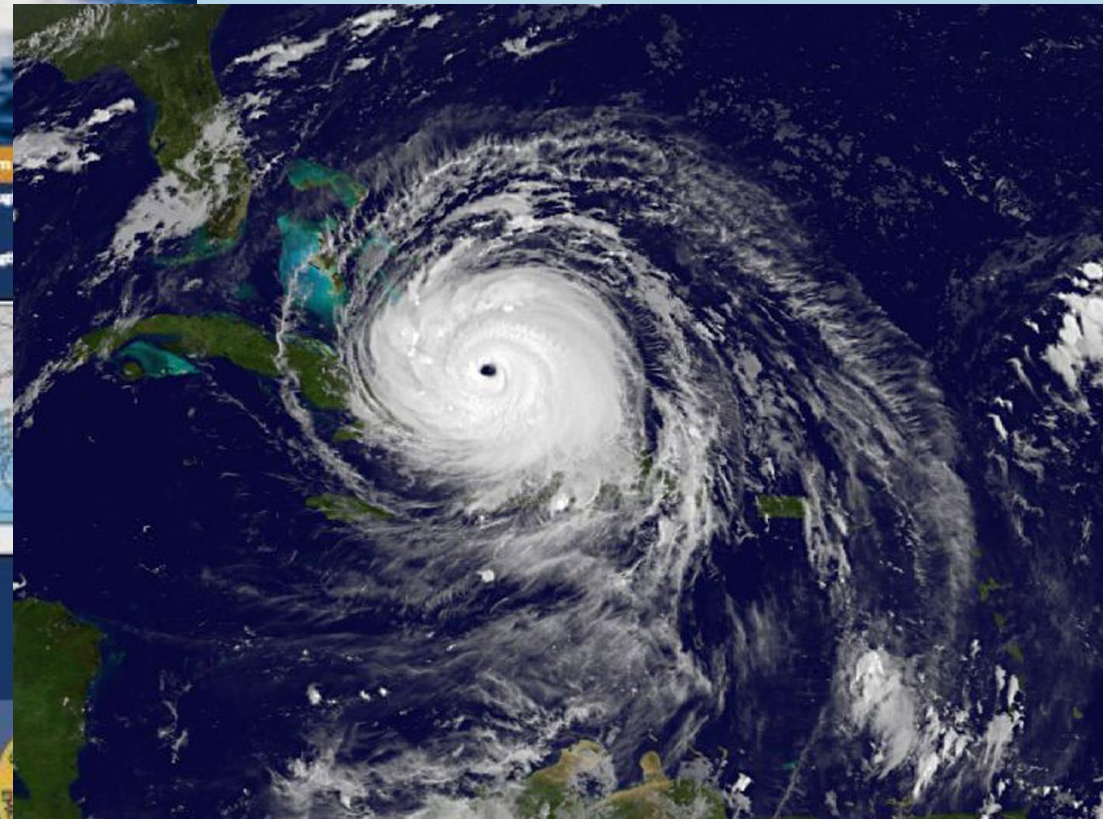

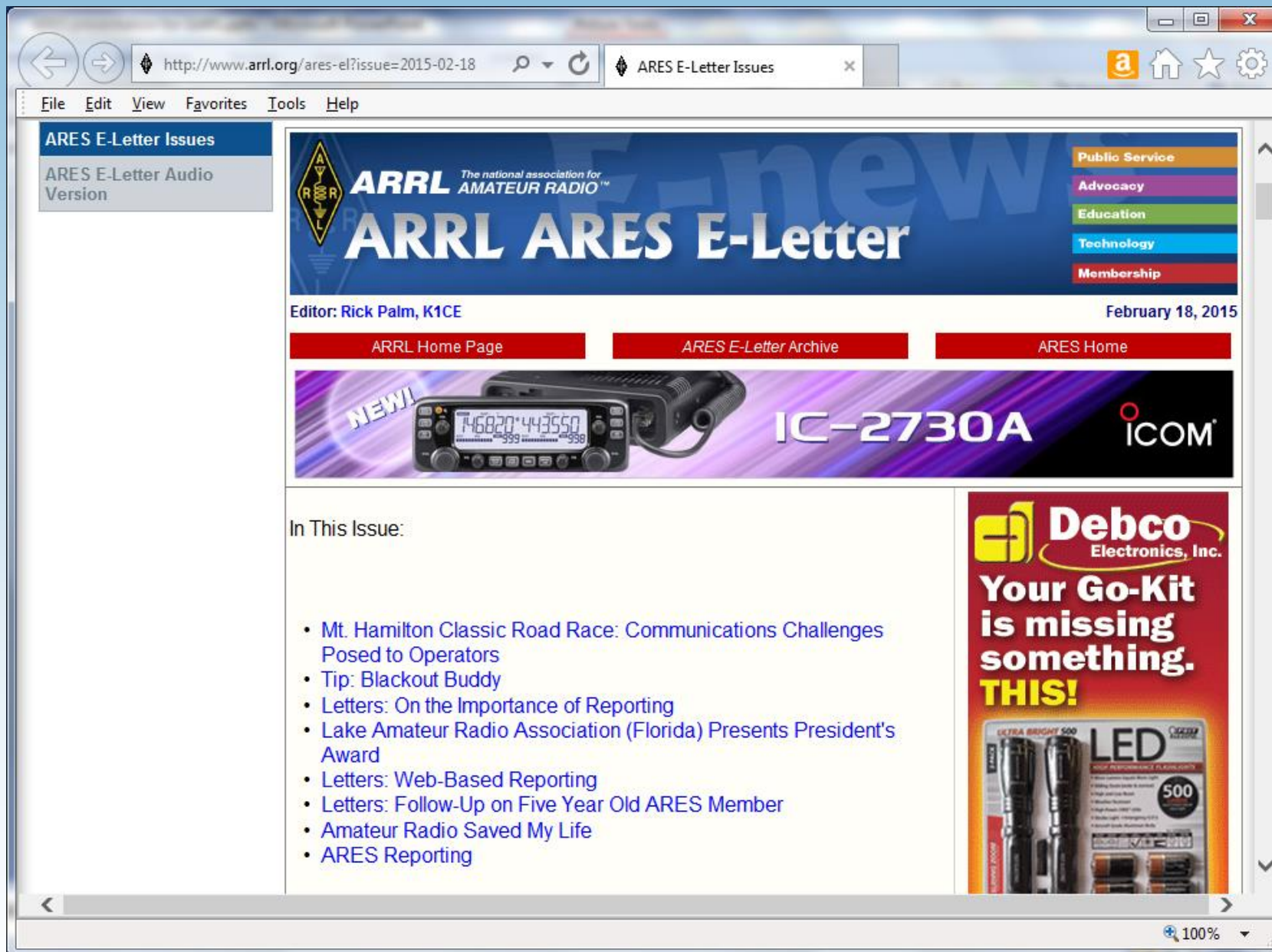

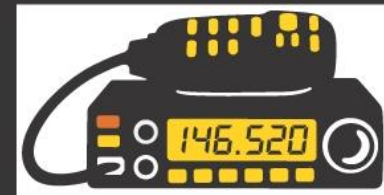
